RE: **PA SHUTDOWN: SITE CLOSURE DEADLINE EXTENSION**

Last night, Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf amended his order to close all non-life-sustaining businesses to extend the closure deadline. All businesses that do not comply will be cited, fined, or have their licenses suspended.

Enforcement of the amended order will now begin on **Monday, March 23 at 8:00 AM**. Please work with your project GCs and owners to ensure the orderly shutdown of non-exempt job sites.

This construction shutdown does not apply to **emergency repairs** or work on **health care facilities**. These jobs may continue physical operations without waivers.

In addition, exemptions to the shutdown order may be granted for other business activities if they are deemed “life-sustaining” by the Department of Community & Economic Development. Waivers will be granted on a case by case basis. To apply for a waiver, [click here](#).
