Update: Families First Coronavirus Response Act

On Saturday, March 14, 2020, the U.S. House of Representatives [passed](#) the [Families First Coronavirus Response Act \(H.R. 6201\)](#).

NECA has been closely tracking this legislation as it moves through the highly complex legislative and political process. At this point, it is just a House-passed bill.

This legislation is not yet final as it has not been passed by the U.S. Senate or presented to the White House for final approval. The earliest this would happen would not be for several more days.

When it is officially signed into law, NECA will provide an overview for our entire membership of what the law entails and how it will impact our contractors.
