RE: **PA GOV: TIME-LIMITED RESTRICTIONS LIFTING JANUARY 4**

On December 30, Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf [announced](#) that the time-limited COVID-19 mitigation measures effected December 12 will expire on January 4, 2021 at 8:00 AM.

At that time, the Commonwealth's COVID-19 mitigation efforts will revert to those in place on December 11, 2020. Please click on the link below to review these measures:

Below is a sample of relevant mitigation efforts remaining in effect:

- Construction remains at full capacity with continued implementation of all previous health and safety protocols,
- All in-person businesses may operate at 75% occupancy (with limited exceptions),
- Masks remain required in businesses, and face coverings are generally required indoors and outdoors when away from home,
- Telework must continue unless impossible,
- The [out-of-state testing requirement](#) remains in place,
